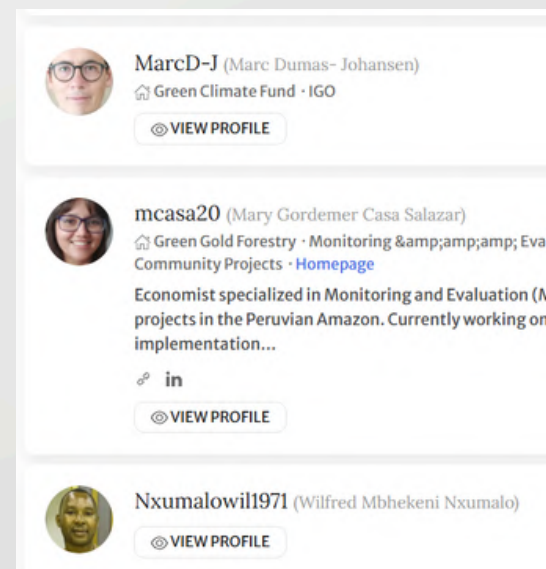

Upgraded REDD+ Discussion Forum

Social Network Function

REDD+ Web Platform users can choose to share personal information, such as their organization's website, web links, and email address. This information can be made visible either to other REDD+ Web Platform users only or to the general public.



UN Climate Change recently upgraded the discussion forum on the REDD+ Web Platform. While maintaining its core function as a place for Platform users to exchange REDD+-related information, the upgrade introduced new social networking features designed to enhance interaction, collaboration, and knowledge sharing among users.



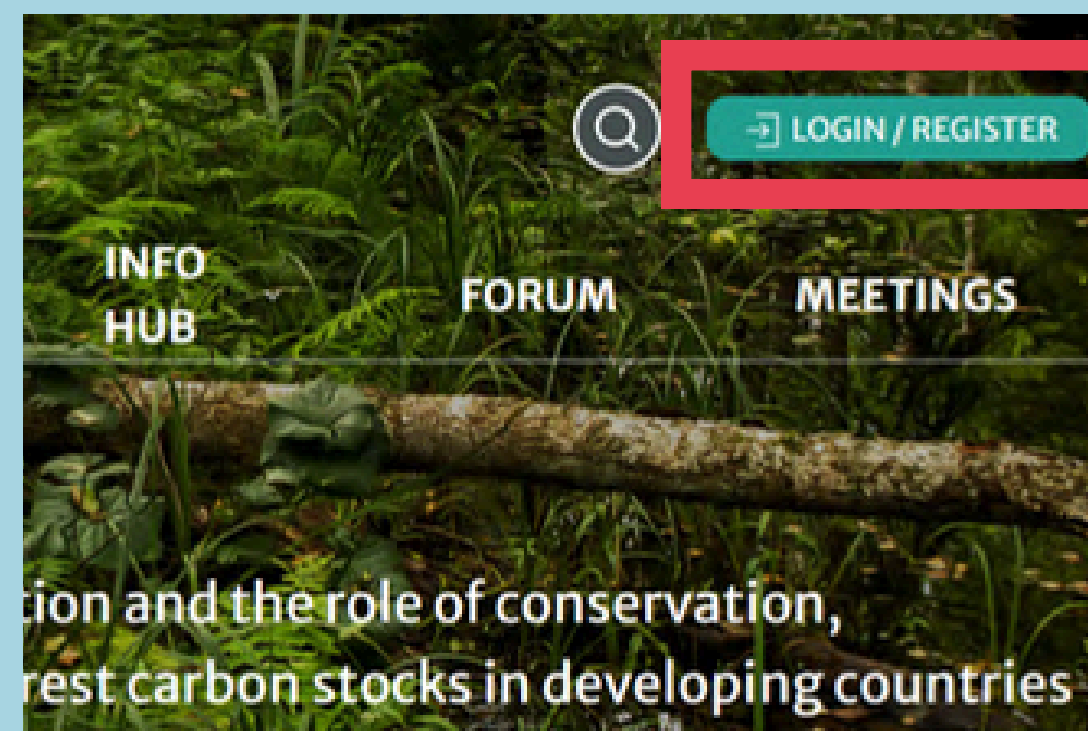


Setting Guidance

Step 1:

Login to the REDD+ Web Platform

1. Click **LOGIN/REGISTER** on the [REDD+ Web Platform homepage](#)
2. Enter your username (or email address) and password, then click **LOGIN**
3. If you have forgotten your password, click **Forgot your password?** and follow the instructions.
4. If you have forgotten your username, please contact redwebplatform@unfccc.int.



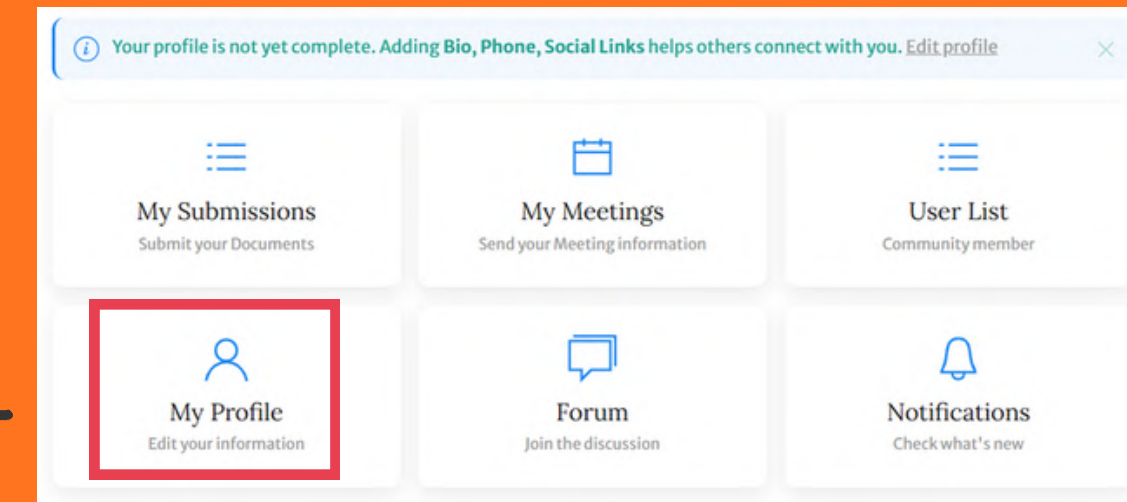
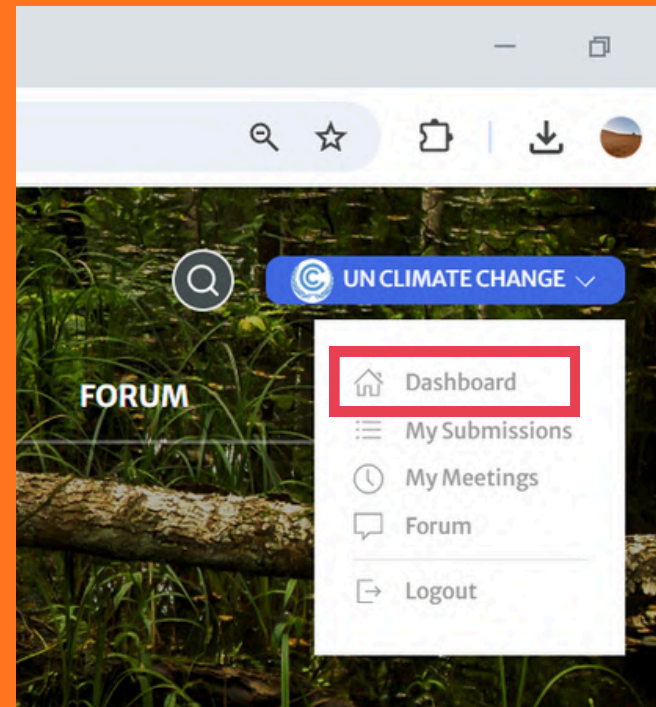

Step 2: Setting Up Your Profile

Complete Your REDD+ Platform Profile

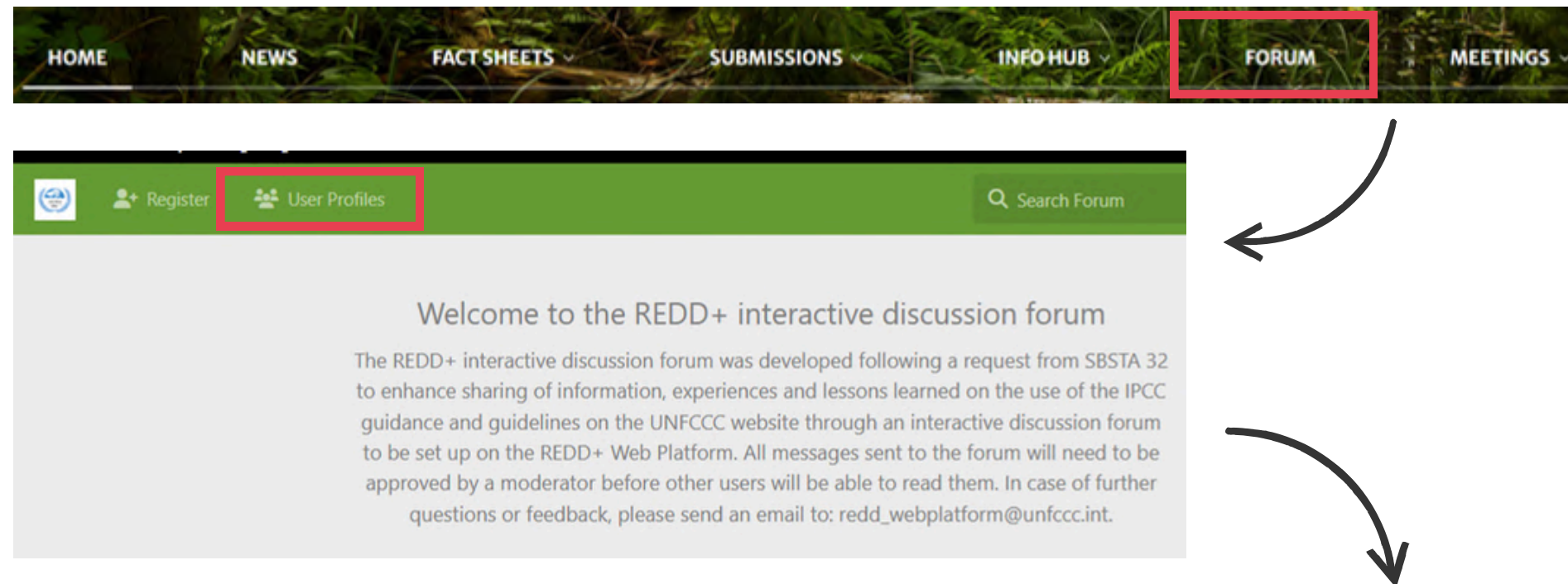
1. Click on **your account menu** on the top of the page
2. Select **Dashboard**, then click **My Profile**
3. Complete or update your personal information
4. At the bottom of the page, you can manage your Privacy Settings.
5. For each profile field, you can choose its visibility: **Public**, **Registered users only**, or **Hidden**.

Choose who can see each piece of information.

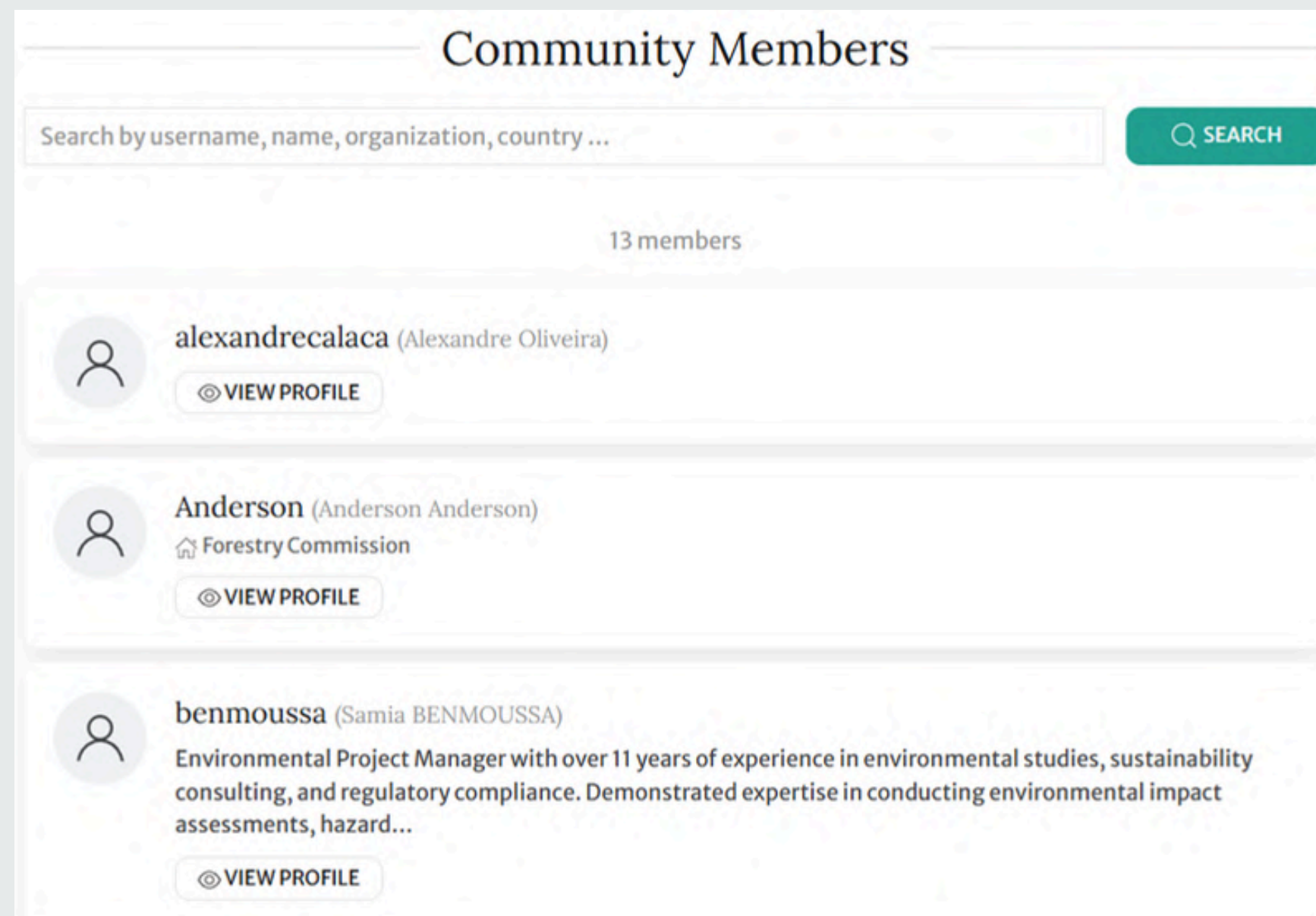

Activity Data: Different Methodologies, Different Results

One of the technical challenges, also discussed during the recent REDD+ Summit session was the fact that different methodologies for generating Activity Data can lead to different results.

Many countries are using different approaches, datasets, definitions, and classification methods to identify deforestation and land-use change. As a result, estimates of forest loss can vary significantly depending on the methodology applied. Even within a country, different methodologies (for example, a wall-to-wall approach versus a sample-based approach) can result in different estimates and outcomes.

How do countries know which methodology is the most appropriate to use while at the same time ensuring consistency, transparency, and comparability of results?

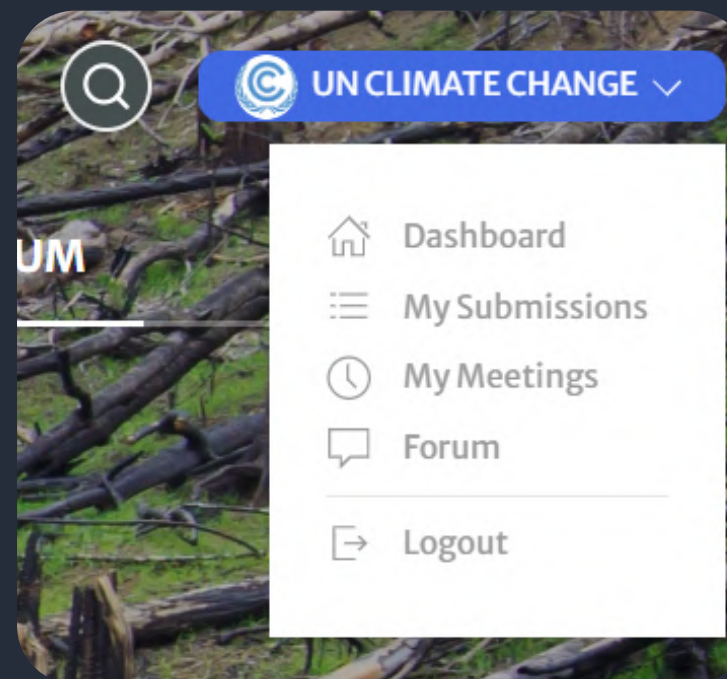
